Optimist B

International participants must at least bear a junior sailor's license issued by the national Sailing Association. To start in Class A eligibility to do so must be legitimated according to class and national rules. Alternatively, the race office shall accept sufficient evidence to be qualified for Class A racing. **The start legitimation will be controlled by sample check.**

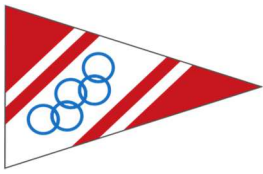
Entry

Entry Fee

Opti A: Entry Fee € 45,-- (for delayed entry € 70,-- will be charged).

€ 5,-- disposal for the group sign is included and will be paid when returning the group sign.

Opti B: Entry Fee: € 40,-- (for delayed entry € 65,-- will be charged).

Entry Restrictions and Groups

The organizing committee reserves the right to limit **entries** in **Class A** to **220** and in **Class B** to **100** boats. The participant list will be closed after 220 (100) boats have been accepted **according to the date of entry**.

The group sign for Class A must be shown on the very top of the rig and has to be given back at the race office after the last race. Only group signs in **perfect condition** will be taken back.

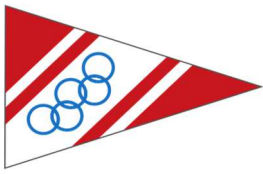

14:00 Last possible starting time

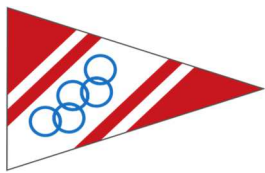
6 races overall are scheduled.

Advertising

Advertising is allowed according to Category C of World Sailing rules.

Measurement

Measurement of equipment and inspection of safety equipment can be done. Measurement certificates must be held ready for inspection. There will be no measurement options for equipment.



Safety Equipment

In addition to class rules 4.3 and 4.5 all boats shall have a paddle, a bailing-device with at least 3 l capacity and a floatable haul (diameter at least 5 mm) of at least 8 m length which must be attached to the mast base. Personal buoyancy must be worn at all times.

Insurance

All participants must have sufficient insurance cover for regatta sailing and demonstrate insurance documents on check-in.

Score-System

The Low-Point-System according to appendix A of World Sailing rules shall apply.

1 race will be eliminated from the score if at least 4 races have been sailed.

Nation scoring: Total of points of the best three sailors per nation (low-point).

Prices

Prices will be given to the first 20 sailors in Class A and B.

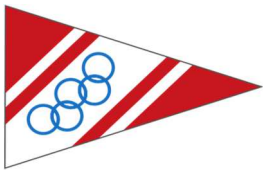
Image and film rights
